When called, the indictment is read to him, and he is to plead guilty or not guilty...I was overcome by the good Spirit as I considered that and the thought came, “The church is being brought to an arraignment, and the charges have been brought against her and her sons for the condition of the church.” I was overcome by the message that God was indicting each of us, and the church, and the nation, and that we were called to give an account.

As I considered the church and how it would be arraigned, there was recalled to my mind these words. *And his people wrought righteousness, and obtained heaven, and sought for the city of Enoch which God had before taken, separating it from the earth, having reserved it unto the latter days, or the end of the world; And hath said, and sworn with an oath, that the heavens and the earth should come together; and the sons of God should be tried so as by fire (Genesis 14:34-35).* I’d read this scripture many times, possibly as you have, and many others scriptures about the trial of our faith. I always considered that trial to be a testing. I understand it now to be an arraignment.

Not only is the church to be tried and tested for her faithfulness, but she must be arraigned before the bar of God.
