By Arthur Oakman (Endowment Series p. 101-102)

Oakman: "This church was conceived by the ministry of angels. It was not brought forth by human instrumentality except as Joseph Smith and those around him responded to the ministry to those who were from above. It was Moroni, Peter, James and John, and John the Baptist who appeared to him. It was from these brethren that Joseph received his call and ordination to the priesthood and under the continual guidance of those who were from above, the church moved in the discharge of its responsibility. Brethren, never let us forget that the hope of the Kingdom does not rest here below with men on the earth outside of the Church. It rests with men who are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. Our communion is with them. And as the writer to the Hebrews said, "Ye are come unto Mount Sion...to an innumerable company of angels (Hebrews 12:22)." That is to whom we have come.

Overshadowing this world there is an innumerable company of those who have gone on before...men of faith who wrought righteousness, who under the power of God by exercise of their faith wrought and subdued every principality and power that stood in the way of the accomplishment of the work of God. This is the heritage of the servants of God...What does it say of the power of the Melchisedec priesthood? To have the heavens open unto them, to commune with God, with Jesus Christ, and have the communion of the Church of the First Born (D&C 104:9b). This comes as a result of continual, careful study, fasting, praying, and continual unremitting search for truth which are from above."

In the above statements, Bro. Oakman reminds us what is possible if our priesthood will fully commit themselves to the cause of Christ. As we continue forward into the New Year may the women of the church, not only work in their designated areas of responsibilities but may we uphold the priesthood in mighty prayer, that the endowment may flow down upon the priesthood and the church as a whole, that all may be edified, and Zion established. Pray for the priesthood, pray for the church, pray for the endowment and pray for Zion. The solemn assembly was just the first step in the windows of heaven being opened. Our continued dedication and prayers are a part of that process. Doctrine and Covenants 65 is called a revelation on prayer to the church and we are told to pray for Zion.

Oakman says: "I remember as a small boy hearing my paternal grandmother telling the family that the night before she had a vision. She had seen the place on earth from which the City of Enoch had been taken. In my impressionable mind it stayed with me, and it is still with me to this day... She bore testimony that she knew the City of Enoch was real and was concerned with what was transpiring on the earth. The city of Enoch, this innumerable company of angels, are men who have labored upon the earth; and into that city have gathered since that time those who through their faith have found redemption. They are waiting to return to the earth to claim their inheritance. The world has not been cleansed to be made a fit place for their habitation before this because God in His mercy has seen fit to restrain the devouring flood of destruction in order that some few of His children might repent and create upon this earth a fit counterpart—so that heaven and earth could come together, and the sons of God be tried so as by fire"

Oakman then speaks of the order of the Everlasting Covenant of the Holy Priesthood and says: "By faith they should have power to work righteousness, to subdue kingdoms and principalities, to set at defiance the armies of the earth, to break every band, and to stand in the presence of God. Can you imagine us doing these things? When we read of the privileges and the powers which are attached to the Melchisedec priesthood—what lies before us and what is possible of achievement through faith—we cannot but bow our heads and say, 'Lord, I believe; help thou mine unbelief (Mark 9:21).' This is the power by which the Kingdom of Zion shall be brought to pass. It is the power of God; and it centers in that radiant company, the company of the redeemed—who wait in their place until the day shall come when God shall say, 'It is enough' Then shall they return to the earth and have place until the end comes."

Oakman asks us, "Can you imagine these things?" <u>Can we? Are we ready as a people for the tasks that are before us? Are we ready for Enoch's City? If not, why not?</u> God has warned us over & over that the time is short. We must move forward in our preparation. Let us be mighty in prayer, fasting and study that = The Windows of Heaven Will Be Opened and the Promised Blessings Poured Out, that we Might Be Made Ready! <u>Now is the Time for Action!!</u>

After outlining the signs of the times and the wars and rumors of war, Jesus said, "And Again, this gospel of the Kingdom shall be preached in all the world, for a witness...and then shall the end come (Matthew 24:32 & Mark 13:36)." How can the gospel of the Kingdom be preached in all the world for the witness until there is a visible Kingdom of which witness could be borne? Then He said, "The Son of man shall come, and he shall send his angels before him with the great sound of a trumpet (Matthew 24:40)." Before the coming of the Son of man, we men of the ministry may expect the visitation of a glorious retinue of those who have gone before.

On the third day of April, 1836...in the Kirtland Temple, Oliver Cowdry and Joseph Smith dropped the veils behind the pulpits and knelt down in solemn and earnest prayer. There appeared to them the Son of man, glorious in His description, exactly as He is described in the book of Revelations. Then Elijah, whose function was to turn the hearts of the children to their fathers and the fathers to the children. (Church History 2:46-47) That power to turn the hearts of the children to their fathers is in this Church. Who are the fathers? Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, and Joseph are our fathers.

What was the promise to them which would be planted in our hearts? In thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed (Genesis 22:22). That was the primary promise.

This is still the purpose of God, that in the midst of the nations there shall be a revelation not alone of social justice, but a revelation on the Kingdom of God socially—for Christ is the Savior of society as well as the Savior of individuals. So it was that Jesus talked to Joseph Smith and Oliver Cowdry and told them that He should come and send His angels before Him. In the Kirtland Temple not only Elijah appeared, but Moses appeared to them and gave them the keys of gathering the 12 tribes of Israel. And Elias the restorer appeared to them and committed to them the keys of the restoration of all things. Those men had converse with spiritual powers which are not of this world...This church must recapture the genius which made that possible!

#### **Last Days Experiences – Card 1**

Karl, in preparation to preach was considering the conditions in the church and some of the messages given to the church by his grandfather, Apostle Joseph Luff. Two in particular; one being the song *Admonition* and the other a message in poetic verse called the *Arraignment*.



Karl says: According to Webster, Arraignment means = To call or set a prisoner at the bar of a court to answer the matter charged against him. An indictment for information. When called, the indictment is read to him, and he is to plead guilty or not guilty...I was overcome by the good Spirit as I considered that and the thought came, "The church is being brought to an arraignment, and the charges have been brought against her and her sons for the condition of the church." I was overcome by the message that God was indicting each of us, and the church, and the nation, and that we were called to give an account.

As I considered the church and how it would be arraigned, there was recalled to my mind these words. And his people wrought righteousness, and obtained heaven, and sought for the city of Enoch which God had before taken, separating it from the earth, having reserved it unto the latter days, or the end of the world; And hath said, and sworn with an oath, that the heavens and the earth should come together; and the sons of God should be tried so as by fire (Genesis 14:34-35). I'd read this scripture many times, possibly as you have, and many others scriptures about the trial of our faith. I always considered that trial to be a testing. I understand it now to be an arraignment.

Not only is the church to be tried and tested for her faithfulness, but she must be arraigned before the bar of God.

And so, I prayed about that all morning long, and so this was my question, "What would you say to your church in light of that which I have experienced?" As I prayed for the church at large, I was visited by a manifestation of the Spirit, much stronger, much more potent than before. The Spirit fell upon me in great power. Elijah has appeared to the men of this generation. In their priesthood has been bestowed the longing and the promise of Zion and the power and the capacity to turn the hearts of the children to their fathers and the fathers to their children. This we received from above---it did not



originate upon the earth or among men. If I were to ask you, what is the covenant with us in these Last Days, I wonder what the response would be? It is, "I (the Lord) hold forth and deign to give you greater riches, even a land of promise...upon which there shall be no curse when the Lord cometh...and this shall be my covenant with you, Ye shall have it for the land of your inheritance, and for the inheritance of your children forever (Doctrine & Covenants 38:4d-f)."

Brethren, there has to be an economic basis for the demonstration of righteousness in a social way in these latter days. There has to be means on the earth by which the City of Zion is sustained, and not only that, a means by which the earth itself is sanctified.

The gathering is just as important today as it was in the day when Joseph Smith was here among us...you know the promise, "Zion shall not be moved out of her place, notwithstanding her children are scattered, they...shall return...with songs of everlasting joy (Doctrine & Covenants 98:4g)."...I believe that every branch of this church should be a clearinghouse for the gathering in which people of the church practice the laws of stewardship one with another. If they practice the laws of stewardship in the places where they are, they shall be prepared to come to the Center Place to make the glorious demonstration of righteousness. And righteousness and truth will I cause to sweep the earth as with a flood, to gather out mine own elect from the four quarters of the earth, unto a place which I shall prepare; an holy city, that my people may gird up their loins, and be looking forth for the time of my coming; for there shall be my tabernacle, and it shall be called Zion; a New Jerusalem (Genesis 7:70).

#### **Last Days Experiences – Card 2**

As I prayed for the church at large, I was visited by a manifestation of the Spirit...The Spirit fell upon me in great power...suddenly the Spirit brought me to the top of a battleship on which I had previously stood.

From my vantage point, I could see the mooring pins on the ship. The immense size caused me to marvel, as they did when I had actually stood there, the pins dwarfed me. And around those mooring pins, if you can imagine, was a great chain used to moor the ship to the dock. And the links and the chain were bigger than I was. And so we took a picture of that. And now, the Spirit had carried me back to that vantage point on top of the ship. I was struck by the overall scale of the ship, its size, its dimensions, its mooring pins. Then the Spirit spoke to me these words, "IS THE SHIP SAFELY MOORED?"

I was made aware that the ship was the *church*, and I was caused to consider whether or not she was safely moored. Was she safe in harbor and moored safely to the dock? Then I heard these words, as if a warning, "<u>BATTEN DOWN THE HATCHES</u>." Batten down the hatches is a nautical term which literally means = secure the ship's hatch and tarpaulins, especially when rough weather IS EXPECTED. Prepare it for difficulty or crises.

I was again flooded by the Holy Spirit, now stronger than before. I couldn't shake the thought that the warning was coming to the church to prepare it for the storm ahead and for the coming crises. Then suddenly as I dwelt upon those words, it was recalled to my mind that the ship upon which I stood was the USS Missouri in Pearl Harbor. A couple years previously, I remembered Margie and I going to Pearl Harbor visiting the memorial there, and also seeing the Arizona where it sunk, and then going to the USS Missouri and boarding the battleship. #### **Last Days Experiences – Card 3**

I remember it was on the USS Missouri that President Truman signed the treaty, ending the war with Japan...He insisted that if the war was to be ended, that the treaty had to be signed on the USS Missouri.

I looked up the USS Missouri, and the first thing I was presented with was: The ship was de-commissioned, but ultimately re-commissioned in 1986 to provide support for the Gulf War—Desert Storm. And then it was retired to serve as a museum representing her faithful service in multiple wars.

Can you see the parallels? I can't begin to tell you the parallels...It was on the USS Missouri that the treaty ending the war was signed and it being re-commissioned for one final battle before being dry-docked and being prepared to be a representation of its faithful service. Of all the Iowa class battleships, the Missouri was chosen to be the museum.

Why is it docked today? Why was it de-commissioned? The church needs a faithful crew to return her to a safe harbor, and to moor her tightly and prepare her to be a monument of God's faithfulness... The church today needs a faithful crew to bring it to safe harbor and to moor it for the coming storm and the great crises that is just before her. To understand that, you will have to pray about it... I want you to think about this message and pray about it. Is the ship safely moored? And are you prepared to batten down the hatches for the great storm that is just before you?

I was then prompted to share the experience with my brother, Aaron Smith. Aaron responded saying, "Karl, this is a confirmation to me of what is about to unfold." He then shared with me that on several occasions recently, he had had several experiences telling him that judgment is coming—and it's coming swiftly...Then Aaron reminded me of an experience shared in a sermon by Ed Story...about a ship.

If I were to choose a text it would be: And blessed are they who shall seek to bring forth my Zion at that day, for they shall have the gift and the power of the Holy Ghost; And if they endure unto the end, they shall be lifted up at the last day, and shall be saved in the everlasting kingdom of the Lamb (I Nephi 3: 187-188). This is the promise given to the men and women of this day... I know this is a difficult day, a day when men's hearts are failing them for fear, but it ought not to be so among you. Your brethren have the assurances of the gospel of Jesus Christ that the forces of destruction shall not be permitted to engulf the world as to make impossible the redemption of Zion and the completion of the task in which you are engaged. I can bear personal testimony that God is able to save to the uttermost those who put their trust in Him. The endowment will come when we extend ourselves. Verily I say, Men should be anxiously engaged in a good cause, and do many things of their own free will, and bring to pass much righteousness; for the power is in them, wherein they are agents unto themselves...But he that doeth not anything until he is commanded, and receiveth a commandment with doubtful heart, and keepeth it with slothfulness, the same is damned (Doctrine & Covenants 58:6d, f).

Gentlemen there are people lying upon beds of affliction in this city, who I am sure could be healed if there were more virtue in the Church. And where will that virtue come from, except it is through the discipline that we ourselves voluntarily undertake in the cause of Christ?

Remember: And if it so be that you should labor all your days, in crying repentance unto this people, and bring save it be one soul unto me, how great shall be your joy with him in the kingdom of my Father (Doctrine & Covenants 16:3f)!

"In 1833 the early saints were driven out of Independence... Joseph Smith was told to gather 500 young men from the eastern states and to go on a journey from Kirtland to Jackson County (DC 100)...Instead of 500 responding to the call 198 responded. So, 302 men said, "We will wait and see if this prospers before we venture our wealth and our lives in it."

Suppose that 500 had responded and suppose in the discipline of the journey from Kirtland to Independence, they had many marvelous experiences. If they had entered Jackson County peacefully, they might have redressed the balance of power here—had they kept the law. The Lord said, 'Wherefore a commandment I give unto you, to prepare and organize yourselves by a bond or everlasting covenant that cannot be broken...that the church may stand independent above all other creatures beneath the celestial world (Doctrine & Covenants 77:2d-e).' Oakman then comments: How it would have changed the world, if 500 had responded to Joseph's call to go to Missouri, even to the point that the 2 great World Wars might have not taken place. We have to assume some responsibility for what goes on in the world.

Satanic majesty is determined that the purposes of God shall not be fulfilled. But in spite of all, it will be fulfilled. God is determined...there should be a demonstration of social justice.

In this section Oakman asks: 'You be the judge of your own life and ask yourself, "Have I done all that I possibly could to advance the cause of Christ?' And let the answer stimulate you to redouble your efforts in His cause that others

might come to know of the glory of God."

Are we ready to redouble our efforts in seeking to build up the Kingdom of God? If not, why not? Will you commit to giving your all in this great cause? The world awaits a people and a city set on a hill to show them the way. Come let us become that people and build that city!

#### **Last Days Experiences – Card 5**

Message given by Karl Anderson, Knob Noster Restoration Branch 2-23-2020

(Karl's experience continued)...In the experience that Ed had, he said John told him that the church had the prevailing winds in its masts. Do you know what that means? You have to be a sailor to really understand this, but from what little I could learn, that a ship takes the winds, the prevailing winds, no matter what direction they are in and turns those winds and uses it to propel



itself through the storm. Do you see the parallel? The church has to have the prevailing winds to get through the storm. But it has to be able to navigate them. And the crew is not sufficient for the day.

There is going to be a great arraignment. The sons of God are going to be tried. And then there will be great judgment. The church has not yet taken its final voyage. The voyage is just ahead. The church must be prepared for the coming storm. She must be moored safely against the crisis, so that she will be able to survive. And as she survives, she will be able to make her final voyage and she will stand as a true testament of her faithfulness. You, brothers and sisters, are the church.

I pray you will consider the message...It's now in the mouth of 3 witnesses. I pray the Lord will witness to you...the coming crises is only a storm—and if the prevailing winds are in our masts, and we are prepared to receive it, it will propel us on through our final voyage. And she will safely return to Zion's harbor. My testimony to you this morning is: The ship will return. The question is—will you be aboard it? The Lord has many promises for you. Many blessings await, even in the midst of the storm. He will ride beside you, but you must prepare.

"I see a great broad valley; it represents the pleasures of this world. Adjacent to it I see a great mountain approached by a series of heights that can be scaled. Through the valley flows a great broad river. Men sought to bulwark the river...governments build levees to contain the river, which represents the great flowing river of sin and crime and war. On the horizon are growing storm clouds.

The day is going to come when the bulwarks men have built shall no longer contain the powers and forces of evil and destruction...The need is very great because it is later than we think...The need is very great that our homes shall be moved to higher ground. Those in the priesthood need to go into the homes of the people and help them to move to higher ground before it's too late.

The way to come higher is by establishing the family altar, reading the scriptures...We need to move our possessions and talents to higher ground. The only things we can save will be the things we give to God and the church. We need to move to higher ground in personal righteousness, in keeping the Sabbath.

#### COME UP HIGHER - BE YE SANCTIFIED

Elder Charlie Booth had this experience in 2020: "I had a dream in which I found myself in a small house. Brother Ron Lidberg (who had passed away in 2011) appeared to me. He looked much younger, perhaps in his twenties. Even though I had not known him then, I recognized him. The unusual aspect of his appearance was that he seemed to be standing about a foot off the floor. He did not speak, but simply looked at me, then turned and walked through a doorway. I followed him through the doorway and the dream ended.

I awoke, wondering and praying about what I had just seen. In particular, I did not understand why he had been standing above the floor. The Lord let me know that Ron had been sent to urge me and others to come up higher, that we needed to be spiritually elevated, and that the time to do so was short."

In September our flash card #113, carried a message from the Lord, given by Patriarch Roy Weldon, which read in part: "...see as this people shall move to higher ground, for every height they shall scale, heaven shall reach down. They shall come in increasing contact with the powers of God."

When Joshua was getting ready to lead the people into the promised land, he spake unto them saying: <u>Sanctify</u> <u>yourselves; for tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you</u> (Joshua 3:5).

#### CMBR Reunion 2021

In the early morning hours of May 24<sup>th</sup>, the Spirit of the Lord prevailed upon me, amidst the midnight watch. I was awakened and prompted to write many things. I had declared to Him the things which I had observed from the watchtower, things that concerned me, and I could see coming. To these things He gave response...Much of what I share with you will be just as it was dictated to me by the Spirit, some more direct than others, just as I was prompted to write it...Much like the plagues of Egypt, God is moving to bring judgment upon the world. For havoc and ruin 'twill surely proclaim... Fierce tempests are brewing, beware of their blast! Their fury will gather in strength to the last.

A plague is in nesting, beware of its breath! Its touch is as mildew, its watchword is death. No rank will escape it, no station be free, nor safety be found on the land or the sea. A panic is pending, commotion and dearth lie close in its path, and the treasures of earth from hands that have held them like dust shall be swept, and poverty enter where wealth has long slept.

A famine is coming, the long fertile field will mock at man's labor, refusing to yield. The earthquakes, increasing, shall sport, as they reel, with towers of granite and strongholds of steel. Disorders upon and disasters beneath, earth's surface shall terror and sorrow bequeath. My nations shall war and people contend, and man must himself 'gainst his neighbor defend.

We were warned in the later day revelation that this was coming (see Joseph Luff's Prophecy on last month's card and Doctrine & Covenants 63:9) and that we were to take righteousness in our hands and faithfulness upon our loins. If Ye have chosen fear as the seed of your planting, then fear and destruction you shall reap. If, however, for your planting you have chosen faith, then ye shall reap for yourselves a harvest of peace and blessings, and you shall countenance the light of Jesus Christ within you.

Nevertheless, His mercies fail not, and he is willing to forgive our transgressions, and heal our hearts of unbelief. Can you not hear His voice, saying, "Come and fall down before the alter, oh church of my choice? See if I will not open my arms to receive You." Nevertheless, many woes are coming. Every man's work shall be made manifest; for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is (1 Corinthians 3:13). This is the fire of God.

#### **The Midnight Hour**

We are surely at the end of the Gentiles. Jerusalem being returned in the 6 days of war fulfilled Jesus' prophecy about the Jews regaining that city many years ago. How close are we to the completion of his many other prophecies regarding his coming again in glory? To that I will leave you these several testimonies and pray that the Holy Spirit will bear witness to you as it has to me of not only the day we live, but the very moment foretold by Jesus during his earthly ministry.

In April 2020, I woke up from sleep, only to roll over and see my digital clock read 11:59. Within seconds, it changed to 12:00. I went back to sleep, not thinking anything of this. The next night, the exact same thing happened. I woke up to see it read 11:59 and then within seconds again, roll to midnight. I'm sure my thoughts were at that point, "What are the chances" or "How odd"—two nights in a row at exactly the same minute---maybe 10 seconds of each other.

When it happened two nights later, I was struck with the significance of this timing. For the third night in the same week, I woke up at 11:59 only to watch it change to midnight. I knew the third time God was speaking to me. He was telling me we lived in the moments right before the cry was to go out to the bridal party to gather for the feast.

Fast forward now to the week of October 2021. Many things have transpired over the last year and half. I've witnessed many who have heeded the call to gather. They see the world collapsing around them and know that the time is now short, when as the Doctrine & Covenants says, we will either take up our sword against our neighbor or we will be forced to flee to Zion for safety. (DC 45:13a)

Earlier that week, as it occurred many times, I woke up in the night. As I rolled over this time, I saw 12:00. I looked at it and because of the significance of my earlier experiences that had been given 18 months prior, the weight of that moment in time and prophecy struck me with sober truth—we have reached the time when the parable of the 10 virgins will be fulfilled. (As a side note I wake up frequently during the night. I can't recall any other times when I've woken up to see midnight exactly. To Be Continued...)

## The Midnight Hour - Card 2 by Aaron Smith

In October 2021 Aaron was awakened exactly at midnight. Aaron then said: "The weight of that moment in time and prophecy struck me with a somber truth—we have reached the time when the parable of the 10 virgins will be fulfilled." (See the July flash card) He continued saying:

Two days later, as I was driving home from work, I was taking a curve on a road not far from my house. As I began that curve there was something in the middle of the road that caught my eye. It was large and it took me a second to recognize it. I had already begun to slow down to avoid hitting it when it struck me there was a carcass in the middle of the road with a large bald eagle standing over it. As I passed it by, slowing way down, it just stood there, never flinching over its meal. Several other cars went by with the same result. It just stood there, not moving other than the flinch of its head occasionally to recognize other traffic headed its way.

I had made it no further than my next turn, or about 100 yards away, and the verse from Matthew 24:28 came to me which says, "And now I show unto you a parable. Behold, wheresoever the carcass is, there will the eagles be gathered together; so likewise shall mine elect be gathered from the four quarters of the earth." There is no doubt in my mind that these two experiences were connected. I have lived for almost 50 years of my life, most of which, we never had eagles live in our area. It hasn't been except for the last 5-8 years that eagles have really begun to live back down as far as south Independence. I have never seen an eagle so large, nor have I seen one eating from a carcass. (Even though I hear that is somewhat regular.)

That night I shared these two experiences with an elder from a different congregation. He was woken up that next night and told to study certain things—especially in relation to the Greek definition of midnight which indicates that it is a time when the drunken fall asleep. He was drawn to the word 'drunken' and told to then study Revelations 17. (To Be Continued)

## The Midnight Hour - Card 3

The elder, Aaron shared his testimony with, was given further testimony of this being true. The elder was drawn to the word "drunken" and told to go to Revelations 17 (See August Flash Card). He immediately saw the parallels and was given emphasis that we do live in the last days where the beast is rising up against the whore/false church and will make her desolate, naked and eat her flesh as is described there. He describes this experience as follows: "I was wrought

upon, as I read this passage of scripture, by the POWER and PRESENCE of the HOLY GHOST, such as I have never experienced before." He was given to know that God has set His hand to claim His bride. He has set in motion the final sequence, and there is no turning back, there is no staying His hand.

Aaron says: "I urge those who read this testimony and those who hear it to do a study on the term midnight in scripture. You will find seven stories in the Bible and two parables with that term. There is no mistaking God's wording or usage of that term. Each of those stories holds a prophetic under current for the return of the King in glory. Both parables (10 Virgins and the Lord's prayer parable found in Luke 11) speak of seven things in common: Both were at midnight, the door was shut, people were asleep, both asked for entrance/help, Jesus is represented in both parables, both questions received an answer, and finally both dealt with food.

The time of midnight in scripture indicates a time of division. It indicates a time of separation, yet of gathering. The implications of this time of history indicate to us that the return of Christ is upon the church." (To Be Continued)
