


Choosing the Pathway of Righteousness and Sanctification on the Journey

- **Restore in Hebrew = Also listed = Apostate, Deny, Heathenish, Backsliding & Idolatrous, Do Evil**
- **Restore in the Hebrew = Also Listed = Refresh, Restore, Build, Render, Circumcise = (Covenant Keeping with God)**
- **Restore in the Hebrew = Also Listed = Rejoice = (Prim Root = to Brighten up, Exceeding Gladness, Be/Make Bright)**
- **Restore in the Hebrew= Also Listed = Reward = (Payment, Compensation, Peace, Prosperity, Safety, Health, Friend, Happy, All is Well, To Be at Rest)**

Repent, Repent, Repent

DC 6:4b Say nothing but repentance unto this generation: keep my commandments, and assist to bring forth my work according to my commandments, and you shall be blessed

What is Righteousness

- **12 Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation... 13 Then will I teach transgressors thy ways; and sinners shall be converted unto thee.**


Look at [Psalms 51](#)

It is found in humility before God, repentance and having a clean heart, then going forth to tell others the ways of God. It is more than this, but a good foundation to build upon.

Pharisees = An example of a group of people who had the wrong concept of righteousness. They took the Laws of God and distorted them.

[Leviticus 11:44-45](#) 44 For I am the Lord your God; ye shall therefore sanctify yourselves, and ye shall be holy . . . 45 For I am the Lord that bringeth you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God; ye shall therefore be holy, for I am holy. In trying to fulfill this law, they went in the wrong direction—into the letter of the law—and lost the spirit of the law. Pharisees began to focus on ritual purity—especially with food—and also the observance with the Sabbath. They took the ritual temple law pertaining to Holiness and tried to bring it into the home to apply the law more broadly. They declared that the ritual law of cleanliness described in God’s will for the temple Priests was God’s will for all the people. All could obtain this Holiness by eating secular food (ordinary everyday meals) in a state of ritual purity, as if one was a Temple Priest.

Jesus Challenged the Pharisees

This led them to the purification of vessels and the washing of hands but also meant that they could not eat with anyone who did not observe Jewish law.

This was called the Law of Table Fellowship. This caused them to clash with Jesus

Luke 5:30 But the scribes and Pharisees murmured against his disciples, saying, Why do ye eat and drink with publicans and sinners?

31 Jesus answering, said unto them, They that are whole need not a physician; but they that are sick.

32 I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

Jesus quoted a scripture from Hosea to them.

Hosea 6:4 O Ephraim, what shall I do unto thee? O Judah, what shall I do unto thee? for your goodness is as a morning cloud, and as the early dew it goeth away.....6 For I desired mercy, and not sacrifice; and the knowledge of God more than burnt offerings. 7 But they like men have transgressed the covenant; there have they dealt treacherously against me.

The Challenge Continued

Luke 15:2 And the Pharisees and scribes murmured, saying, This man receiveth sinners and eateth with them. 3 And he spake this parable unto them, saying, 4 What man of you having a hundred sheep, if he lose one of them, doth not leave the ninety and nine, and go into the wilderness after that which is lost, until he find it?

- The Pharisees were being like the Shepherds in Ezekiel
- Ezekiel 34:2 Son of man, prophesy against the shepherds of Israel, prophesy and say unto them, Thus saith the Lord God unto the shepherds; Woe be to the shepherds of Israel that do feed themselves! should not the shepherds feed the flocks?




Quote from “ Learn of Me” = “Wanting so much to be Holy, the Pharisees who were chastised did not want to hear that their efforts were misguided and were falling short. This would be an indictment of their entire way of life and their confidence of being justified before God through their righteousness deeds. Hearing the vision of holiness which focused on meeting other’s needs rather than merely rejoicing in their own righteousness, they began to recognize changes they could make. The choice was theirs, as it is all of ours to repent or harden our hearts. But choosing to resist the call to repent will lead us to increased hostility toward the One calling us to change.”



Besetting Sins??????????

- The word *beset* is found in [Hebrews 12:1](#): Besetting sins are ones that we continually struggle with and have a weakness toward. According to the Merriam-Webster Dictionary, *besetting sin* refers to **“a main or constant problem or fault”**
- Other translations refer to the sins that “beset” us as **“sin that so easily entangles”** (NIV) and **“sin that just won’t let go”** (CEV). The Greek word used in this verse means **“easily ensnaring”** (Logos Bible Word Study). **Like a trap that easily captures a mouse, there are some sins that easily ensnare us.**

Words of King Benjamin

Mosiah 2:48 **And finally, I can not tell you all the things whereby ye may commit sin: for there are divers ways and means, even so many, that I can not number them.**

49 But this much I can tell you, that if ye do not watch yourselves, and your thoughts, and your words, and your deeds, and observe to keep the commandments of God, and continue in the faith of what ye have heard concerning the coming of our Lord, even unto the end of your lives, ye must perish.

50 And now, O man, remember, and perish not.





The Ark of the Covenant = Was the Symbol of the Lord's Presence


- The Ark of the Covenant was in the center of the procession. Every activity orbited around God. We can not win our battles by anger, finger pointing casting blame on others


I say unto you, listen to me. There are two stewardships that will ensure success if you will do them.


