

JACOB'S SECOND SERMON – II NEPHI 7

- II Nephi 7:1-4 Some Will Perish; Some Will Know Christ
- 7:5-9 Christ Will Be Crucified By The Jews
- 7:10-13 Israel Scattered, Then Gathered
- 7:14-18 Gentiles Will Be Blessed
- 7:19-25 Christ As King Of Zion In This Land

SOME MAJOR POINTS FROM JACOB'S 2ND SERMON

- There is no other nation that would crucify their God vrs 7
- This is a "land of liberty" and will have no kings vrs 18
- Gentiles will be blessed vrs 29
- Isles of the sea; others led out from House of Israel vrs 34-38
- You are free to choose Reconcile yourselves to God vrs 40,41
- Only saved by grace vrs 42
- Raised by death because of resurrection; raised from EVERLASTING death by the atonement – vrs 43

- Nephi's going to quote more of Isaiah and apply it to his people
- Isaiah saw the Messiah; so did Nephi and Jacob (vrs 3,4)
 - 3 different witnesses to the Nephites of the coming Messiah
 - Also, foretelling of the 3 witnesses to the BoM in the future?

NEPHI PROVES TO HIS PEOPLE

- II Nephi 8:7 Behold, my soul delighteth in proving unto my people the truth of the coming of Christ:
- 8 For, for this end hath the law of Moses been given:
- 9 And all things which have been given of God from the beginning of the world, unto man, are the typifying of him.
- Law of Moses given to point the way to Christ
- All revelation has been a type and shadow of Jesus Luke 24

THE COVENANT DELIVERS FROM DEATH

- II Nephi 8:10 And also, my soul delighteth in the <u>covenants of the Lord</u> which he hath made to our fathers;
- I I Yea, my soul delighteth in his grace, and his justice, and power, and mercy, in the great and eternal plan of deliverance from death.
- Jesus = the great and eternal plan of deliverance from death
- He demonstrates and balances between grace, justice, power, mercy

CHRIST MUST COME OR WE'RE ALL DOOMED

- II Nephi 8:12 And my soul delighteth in proving unto my people, that save Christ should come, all men must perish.
- I 3 For if there be no Christ, there be no God; and if there be no God, we are not, for there could have been no creation.
- 14 But there is a God, and he is Christ; and he cometh in the fullness of his own time.
- No Christ = No God
- No God = No Creation
- No Creation = No Us

Christ is fully God

WHAT DO WE LEARN FROM II NEPHI 10 THAT COULD BE APPLIED TO OUR LIVES?

- God is sovereign over every nation on the earth. They are subject to his judgment. Nothing is outside his control. This would apply to the nation I happen to live in, wherever I find myself. As a nation, we'll answer for our sins. Perhaps a country thinks they're a superpower and not subject to him, but that's not true. As a nation, the prouder and more boastful we become, the closer we are to judgment.
- God was telling Judah not to rely on alliances with other nations, but instead to rely on, and trust in, Yahweh. Sometimes a nation thinks they'll be alright because they have treaties with nations of great power. Instead, we should be thinking about how much the country we live in believes in God, loves God, worships God.

WHAT DO WE LEARN FROM II NEPHI 10 THAT COULD BE APPLIED TO OUR LIVES?

When a nation doesn't submit to God's will, who will answer the call to be a prophet, like Isaiah did, and cry out against wickedness in high places? Or is the country we live in going to simply experience the consequences of its decisions and let God's judgment take its course?
