HOPE



Job 11:13-20 **13** If thou prepare thine heart, and stretch out thine hands toward Him; **14** If iniquity be in thine hand, put it far away, and let not wickedness dwell in thy tabernacles. **15** For then shalt thou lift up thy face without spot; yea, thou shalt be steadfast, and shalt not fear; **16** Because thou shalt forget thy misery, and remember it as waters that pass away; **17** And thine age shall be clearer than the noontday; thou shalt shine forth, thou shalt be as the morning; **18** **And thou shalt be secure, because there is hope;** yea, thou shalt dig about thee, and thou shalt take thy rest in safety. **19** Also thou shalt lie down, and **none shall make thee afraid;** yea, many shall make suit unto thee. **20** But the eyes of the wicked shall fail, and they shall not escape, and their hope shall be as the giving up of the ghost.

Psalms 31:24 Be of good courage, and He shall strengthen your heart, all ye that **hope** in the Lord.

Psalms 33:18 Behold, the eye of the Lord is upon them that fear Him, upon them that **hope** in His mercy.

Psalms 146:5 Happy is he that hath the God of Jacob for his help, whose **hope** is in the Lord his God.

Jeremiah 17:7 Blessed is the man that trusteth in the Lord, and whose **hope** the Lord is.

Joel 3:16 The Lord also shall roar out of Zion, and utter His voice from Jerusalem; and the heavens and the earth shall shake; but the Lord will be the **hope** of His people, and the strength of the children of Israel.

Lamentations 3:22-26 This I recall to my mind, **therefore have I hope.** **22** It is of the Lord's mercies that we are not consumed, because His compassions fail not. **23** They are new every morning; great is thy faithfulness. **24** The Lord is my portion, saith my soul; therefore will I **hope** in Him. **25** The Lord is good unto them that wait for Him, to the soul that seeketh Him. **26** It is good that a man should both **hope** and quietly wait for the salvation of the Lord.

Alma 16:143 And now as I said concerning faith: Faith, is not to have a perfect knowledge of things; therefore if ye have faith, ye **hope** for things which are not seen, which are true.

Romans 5:1-5 **1** Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ; **2** By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and **rejoice in hope** of the glory of God. **3** And not only this, but we glory in tribulations also; knowing that tribulation worketh

patience; **4** And patience, experience; and experience, hope; **5** And **hope** maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.

Romans 8:24-25 **24** For we are saved by **hope**; but **hope** that is seen is not hope; for what a man seeth, why doth he yet hope for? **25** But if we **hope** for that we see not, then with patience we do wait for it.

Romans 12:12 Rejoicing in **hope**; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer.

Romans 15:4 For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have **hope**.

Hebrews 6:18-19 **18** That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the **hope** set before us; **19** Which **hope** we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast, and which entereth into that within the veil.

Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is the assurance of things **hoped for**, the evidence of things not seen.

1 Peter 3:15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts; and be ready always to give an answer with meekness and fear to every man that asketh of you a reason for the **hope** that is in you.

2 Nephi 2:28-30 **28** Behold, I say unto you, Nay; for ye have not come thus far, save it were by the word of Christ, **with unshaken faith in Him**, relying wholly upon the merits of Him who is mighty to save; **29** Wherefore, ye must press forward with **a steadfastness in Christ, having a perfect brightness of hope, and a love of God and of all men.** **30** Wherefore, if ye shall press forward, feasting upon the word of Christ, and endure to the end, behold, thus saith the Father: Ye shall have eternal life.



HOPE AND WAIT

Meaning in the Strong's Concordance



It is good that a man should both hope and quietly wait for the salvation of the Lord.

—Lamentations 3:26

We go to the Strong's Concordance to expand our understanding of the scriptures:

The word Wait and the word Hope have very similar meanings in the Hebrew.

Wait in the Hebrew = To Expect, Look, Patiently, Tarry, Be Still, Quietly Wait, Hold Peace, Forbear, Expectant Hope, Expectation of God, Trust and Rest.

Hope in the Hebrew= Expectation, Wait, Patient, Trust, Tarry.

In several scriptures, Hope and Wait converge together in the Strong's through #3176 which leads to #3177 which leads to #410 The Names of God. **So, both Hope and Wait take you to The Names of God.**

Such Names as : Elpelet = God of Deliverance, Elyashiyb = God will Restore, Eldad = God has Loved, Eliyezer = God of Help, Eliysuwar = God of the Rock, Eliyshama = God of Hearing, Eldaah = God of Knowledge, Elyacaph = God is the Gatherer, Eliyam = God of the People, Jehovah-Jireh = God will supply or see to it, Jehovah Reeb = God will contend/fight your battles, El Elyon = The God Most High, El Moshah = The God Who Saves, El Roi = The God Who Sees Me

Then we have the names we are more familiar with such as: Gentle Shepherd, Rock of Ages, Mighty Fortress, Living Waters, Bread of Life, Great Creator, The Door, Great Physician, Lion of Judah, Great I Am, The Savior, Advocate, The Resurrection and The Life, Master, Head of the Church, Teacher, Light of the World, Image of the Invisible God, Bridegroom, Chief Corner Stone, Redeemer, Author & Finisher of the Faith, Lamb of God, Lion of Judah, Anchor, Only Begotten Son, Bright and Morning Star, The Way, The Truth, The Light, The Life, The Son of God, Judge, Servant, True Vine, Messiah, Alpha and Omega, Man of Sorrows, Lord of Lords, King of Kings, Wonderful, Counselor, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

With such a powerful, loving Heavenly Father we can certainly trust Him in all things and have Peace and Hope as we Wait upon Him.

Psalms 78:7 That they might set their **hope** in God, and **not forget the works of God**, but keep His commandments.

Psalms 119:43 And take not the **word of truth** utterly out of my mouth; for I have **hoped** in Thy judgments.

Psalms 119:49 Remember the **word unto Thy servant**, upon which thou hast caused me **to hope**.

Psalms 119:74 They that fear Thee will be glad when they see me; because I have **hoped in Thy word**.

Psalms 119:81 My soul fainteth for Thy salvation; but I **hope in Thy word**.

Psalms 119:114 Thou art my hiding place and my shield; I **hope in Thy word**.

Psalms 119:116 Uphold me according unto Thy word, that I may live; and let me not be ashamed of my **hope**.

Psalms 130:5 I wait for the Lord, my soul doth wait, and **in His word** do I **hope**.

Romans 15:4 For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and **comfort of the scriptures might have hope**.

Colossians 1:5 For the **hope** which is laid up for you in heaven, **whereof ye heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel**.
