Nomination Instructions

- To be considered historic, properties should generally be a minimum of 50 years, though exceptions can be made for extraordinarily significant structures (such as the Sarasota School of Architecture)
- Properties may be publicly or privately owned, commercial or residential
- Nominations should be located within the boundary of Sarasota County
- The threat to the property can be demolition, neglect, climate change, or longstanding vacancy

Instructions for completing a nomination:

1. Please download the nomination form and save the pdf to your computer. You will be able to click in the boxes to enter information.
2. Review the nomination form to familiarize yourself with the details you will need.
3. You will be asked to include in your email any supplemental historical information, including photographs, designation reports etc.
4. Complete the form to the best of your ability. Please attach additional sheets if the space provided in the boxes is insufficient.
5. Submit the nomination form as an attachment to an email. The email should be addressed to **sahp.mailbox@gmail.com**. Be sure to include all supplemental information and your own contact information in case we have questions.




